



LANGLEY FLIPPERS INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET

July 2nd & 3rd | 2022 | OFFICIAL MEET PACKAGE



LOCATION:

Al Anderson Memorial Pool, Langley City Park; 4949 – 207 Street, Langley, BC

SCHEDULE:

- Warm-ups: 6:15 – 7:30 A.M. (Lanes will be sent out via email.)
- Scratches & Deck Entries: 7:20 A.M. both days.
- Officials' meeting: 7:30 A.M. both days.
- Coaches' meeting: 7:45 A.M. both days.
- Heats: First marshalling at 8:00 A.M. Events start 8:15 A.M.
- Relays: 10 minutes after prelims
- Finals: Warm Up (30 min): Starting 10 minutes after relays.
- Fees paid: 8:30 A.M. Sunday
- Relay lists: 9:30 A.M. both days.

FACILITIES:

- 25 meter – 8 lane outdoor pool; Electronic Timing System.
- Walking trails, playground and waterpark in grounds.
- Concession on both days – breakfast & lunch (see menu attached).
- Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- The green space surrounding the pool is designated for Team and family tents, no RV's. No overnight camping.
- Firepits and BBQ's are **not** allowed within the park area as per the City of Langley.
- Limited Bleacher area will be available for spectators. Pool deck is for officials, coaches and athletes only. No parents or dogs will be allowed on the pool deck.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Both the music school and baseball fields surrounding the pool also have events going on over the same weekend as the swim meet. Please allow extra time for finding parking. Carpooling is encouraged.
- Parking will be available in the 207th Street parking lot and street parking. The 205A Street parking lot will be closed to the public and swim meet participants.
- Please refer to the park diagram at the end of the Meet Package for a visual on designated parking and tent set up.

FUNDRAISING:

- Electronic 50/50 draw will be available for purchase (Credit Card)
 - BC Event Gaming License # 134481
 - Ticket Sales will begin July 2, 2022 and end July 3, 2022
 - Draw will occur between 3:00pm – 5:00pm July 3, 2022 at Al Anderson Memorial Pool
 - Tickets: 3 for \$5.00, 7 for \$10.00, 50 for \$20.00, 200 for \$50.00

FORMAT:

- BCSSA rules apply.
- Cardless Meet format
- Finals (1st – 8th) will be swum.
- Aggregate medals will be awarded for the top swimmer in each male and female Division.
- This is an open meet; there will be no A/B distinction.
- Relays and (6 & Under) will be timed finals.

- At this meet, the working deck includes all of the space behind the starting blocks to the fence, and all space within 1.8 meters of the other 3 edges of the pool. In order to ensure fairness to all swimmers, the working deck will remain off-limits to everyone except swimmers during their events, and officials. Spectators are not permitted inside the working deck area. Swimmers can talk to their coaches, at the coaching tables, and then must exit working deck.
- No parents or guests will be permitted on the pool deck or within the marshalling area. The Warm-Up rules will be in effect and coaches must pre-clear lanes prior to any dive sprints. Safety Marshalls will be monitoring lanes and ensuring the rules are adhered to.
- Events are officially called by the Clerk of the Course in the marshalling area. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to be close enough to hear the Clerk call the events. Any calls made by the announcer over the P.A. system are courtesy calls only.
- Because serious injuries can occur, all loose fitting jewelry must be removed before events. Wearing of tightly fitting jewelry is done at the swimmer's own risk.
- Meet Manager reserves the right to modify meet format if required.
- Results will be posted to meet mobile. A paper copy of the results will be posted on the side of the building.
- Meet Programs will be emailed to club presidents for distribution prior to the meet. A limited number of printed programs will be sold at the swim meet for \$2.00.

OFFICIALS:

- All clubs are required to supply a minimum of 2 Stroke and Turn or Senior Deck Officials, throughout the meet. Please sign up on the Officials Board, on the north east fence corner, by 7:30 A.M.
- Clubs will also be assigned lanes for timers and recorders. Two timers and one recorder are required at all times in each lane. Thanks everyone!

FEES:

- Fraser Valley clubs will pay fees according to the Regional Fee Agreement.
- Individual events - \$6.00 per event for swimmers from outside the Fraser Valley region.
- Relay events - \$7.00 per team from outside the Fraser Valley Region.
- Deck entries - \$8.00 per deck entry.
- There will be no refunds for late scratches.
- We will accept Cheques or Credit Card. Please make cheques payable to: Langley Flippers Swim Club
- **Submit payment to the Meet Manager, by 8:30 A.M. Sunday morning.**

ENTRIES:

- Meet has a maximum capacity of 600 swimmers.
- Swimmers may enter a maximum of **4** individual events and **2** relay events.
- The top 3 heats will be circle seeded for all preliminary rounds, and the remaining heats will be rank seeded, slowest to fastest. Swimmers entered with no time will be seeded in the slowest heats.
- Events during heats will be swum combining Div 1-3 and O-Cat1, and Div 4-8 and O-Cat2. Finals will compete top 8 in each Division.
- **Deck Entries and Scratches** must be submitted to the Clerk of the Course, by 7:20 A.M. on the

day of the event. Deck entries will be accepted as space and time permits without re-seeding. The Meet Manager reserves the right to refuse any deck entry.

- “O” swimmers should be entered in their corresponding “O” category events. The Clerk of the Course may, at their discretion, combine “O” swimmers with the “S” swimmers for the heats. They will swim in “O” Cat 1 or 2 for finals.
- The Clerk of the Course may combine events in heats and finals at their discretion.
- Relay teams may include swimmers from lower divisions but MUST include one team member from the entered division. One “O” cat swimmer may be included per “S” relay.
- **Relay team lists must be written on the entry card and handed in to the Clerk of Course by 9:30 A.M. each morning.**

Deadline for Hy-tek entries is Monday, June 27th, 2022 @ 11:59pm

Scratches may be emailed up until 9:00 pm Wednesday, June 29, 2022

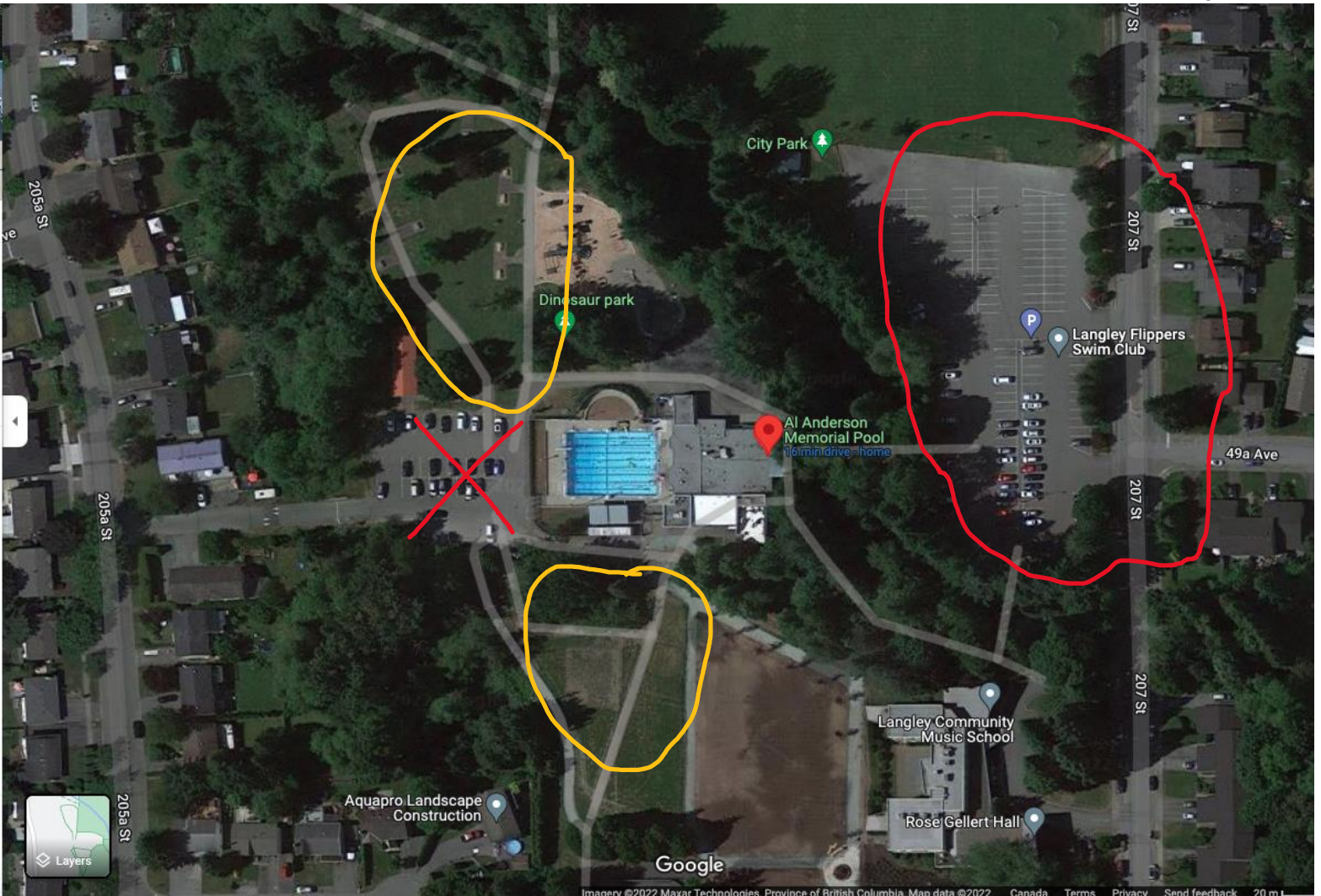
